

RFA - INCARCERATED VETERANS PROGRAM DIRECTOR

The Mississippi Department of Corrections (MDOC) will accept applications until 4:00 pm on Wednesday, August 28, 2019 for the purpose of hiring a contractual Program Director with the following qualifications: a Master's Degree from an accredited four-year college or university and seven (7) years in a criminal justice or human services field, (6) years of which must have included line or functional administrative or advanced technical supervision of veterans, criminal justice-related populations, At-Risk youth, individuals with mental illness, individuals with a history of addiction to drugs and/or alcohol, and/or homeless populations; OR a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited four-year college or university and eight (8) years in a criminal justice or human services field, (6) years of which must have included line or functional administrative or advanced technical supervision of veterans, criminal justice-related populations, At-Risk youth, individuals with mental illness, individuals with a history of addiction to drugs and/or alcohol, and/or homeless populations. Contract will be for the period beginning November 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020 with up to four (4) optional one-year renewals. Contract pay rate is \$40.86 per hour not to exceed \$55,907.68 for the duration of contract ending June 30, 2020 and not to exceed \$85,000.00 annually thereafter upon approved renewal.
