Inmate Escapes Harrison County Community Work Center

JACKSON, MISS. - An inmate convicted in Hinds County escaped the Harrison County Community Work Center in Gulfport tonight.

Christopher D. Epps, 27, is serving a total of 18 years and one day for grand larceny and two counts of burglary larceny of an unoccupied dwelling.

The CWC staff reported Epps missing after 8 p.m.

Epps, MDOC #165446, is a black male of medium build with medium complexion, brown eyes and black hair. He stands 5 feet 7 inches tall and weighs 180 pounds.
