## **Inmate serving life dies Saturday in Greenville hospital**

JACKSON – An inmate serving life for capital murder died Saturday at the Delta Regional Medical Center in Greenville.

Earl Lee Dycus, 66, MDOC#30516, was housed at the Mississippi State Penitentiary at Parchman. His cause and manner of death are pending an autopsy, though no foul play is suspected.

Dycus, MDOC #30516, received the life sentence on August 10, 1983, in Hinds County. He was previously sentenced to 10 years for rape in Yazoo County. The first sentence was handed down November 11, 1975.
