EN BANC ORDER

Before the Court, *en banc*, are the State of Mississippi's Motion to Set Execution Date and Richard Gerald Jordan's Response in Opposition to Motion to Set Execution Date.

After due consideration, the Court finds Jordan has exhausted all state and federal remedies for purposes of setting an execution date under Mississippi Code Section 99-19-106. Accordingly, the Court finds the State's Motion to Set Execution Date should be granted and a date should be set for execution of the death sentence imposed upon Jordan.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Motion to Set Execution Date filed by the State of Mississippi is hereby granted. The execution of the death sentence imposed upon Richard Gerald Jordan shall take place in a manner provided by law on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. C.D.T., or as soon as possible thereafter within the next twenty-four (24) hours.

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED that this Order shall serve as the warrant of execution
for Richard Gerald Jordan.
