Corrections Oversight Task Force discusses issues

JACKSON – The Corrections & Criminal Justice Oversight Task Force met on April 10 at the Caroll Gartin Justin Gartin Building in Jackson.

At the last meeting, featured here in February, members, led by Judge Prentiss Harrell, task force chairman, discussed pending legislation, including two recommendations regarding expungements and transitional housing. They also learned about ongoing activities at the MDOC.
