Substance Abuse Disorder program hosts graduation

GREENWOOD – VitalCore Health Strategies' Long-Term Substance Use Disorder Program at Delta Correctional Facility has graduated 16 participants.

The participants completed courses such as Celebrate Recovery, Moral Reconciliation Therapy, Anger Management, Living in Balance, A New Direction, and the 12 Step Program during the six-month program.

Evangelist Pamela Hilton gave them an encouraging message at the graduation. Her focal point was “I Can” versus “I Can’t”.

Singing and praise dances were a part of the graduation. The graduates performed a skit reflecting on what they have learned and experienced in life. Also, they not only recited the 12 steps but learned to work them.

The program was hosted by the SUD Counselor, Whitney Cosey. The theme was Paris, the City of Light. Cosey said she has seen each graduate's light grow through their effort and commitment during the program.

The graduates are to continue to remain sober, work the 12 steps daily, and take accountability for their actions.
