The Central Mississippi Correctional Facility in Rankin County is among seven state institutions looking for correctional officer recruits.

With a high school diploma or GED plus up to two years' experience, a new recruit can reach the rank of corporal to earn \$40,392.06. A sergeant with up to three years' experience can reach \$44,788.15 and a captain with three to four years' experience can earn \$47,169.30. With a bachelor's degree and three to four years' experience, an officer at the rank of major can earn \$52,388.16.

MDOC positions come with state benefits including retirement; medical, dental, and vision insurance; on-the-job training, vacation and sick leave; and 10 paid holidays.

At minimum, MDOC requires that applicants be at least 18 years of age, have a valid driver's license, and a valid Social Security Card. Applicants must not have any felony or domestic violence convictions. Some misdemeanor convictions may be disqualifying.
