Your request for debriefing must be received within three (3) business days after the issuance of this notice or no later than May 23, 2023.

Vendors are reminded that any protests of this decision must be submitted to Cindy Freeman, Agency Procurement Officer within seven (7) calendar days after the issuance of this notice or no later than May 29, 2023. The protest must be in writing, identify the name and address of the

protestor, provide appropriate identification of the procurement and resulting contract number (if known), and detail the nature of the protest, including available supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims.

The successful vendor is instructed not to begin work, purchase materials, or enter into subcontracts relating to the project or services until execution of the contract.
